HOVERFLY (DIPTERA, SYRPHIDAE) FAUNA RESEARCH ON PEACH TREE

ABSTRACT

We present the results a study of hoverfly larvae and puparia that were taken from the leaves of peach trees. The dominant species were *Episyrphus balteatus* and *Syrphus vitripennis*. *Syrphus vitripennis* and *Syrphus ribesii* probably achieved greater dominance; however, we were unable to determine dead specimens of this genus at the species level.
