ABSTRACT

Krno I. Caddisflies (Trichoptera) and alderflies (Megaloptera) of lower course of the Hron river

In the lower course of the Hron river and its arms (the southwestern of Slovakia), 23 species of caddisflies and 3 species of alderflies were recorded, including Setodes punctatus aurantiacus (Fabricius, 1793), which is vulnerable species of Slovakia. Many species of genus Hydropsychidae were restricted to epipotamal. Ecnomus tenellus (Rambur, 1842), Limnephilus binotatus Curtis, 1834, Mystacides nigra (Linnaeus, 1758), and Leptocerus tineiformis Curtis, 1834 were typical for the arm system of the river Hron.
