ABSTRACT

The critical review deals with three taxons of *Fraxinus* L., native to Slovakia: manna ash (*Fraxinus ornus* L.), common ash (*Fraxinus excelsior* L.) and the Pannonian subspecies of narrow-leaved ash (*Fraxinus angustifolia* Vahl subsp. *damibialis* Pouzar). The emphasis is laid on the problems of their autochthonous occurrence, distribution and presence in the different types of plant communities. These problems are discussed in the context of botany and forest ecology.
