

ADDITIONS AND CORRECTIONS TO „THE MUSCIDAE (DIPTERA) OF CENTRAL EUROPE“, I.

ABSTRACT

The female of *Helina balsaci* (Séguy) is described for the first time. Four additional species to the fauna of the Czech Republic and two species new to Switzerland are recorded and briefly characterized. Some recently published data from Germany and Switzerland are discussed, with their additions to our review of Central European Muscidae (GREGOR et al. 2002). The number of Central European species thus rises to 400; the number of the species known from Germany rises from 321 to 325, from the Czech Republic from 289 to 293, and from Switzerland from 252 to 260.
