NEW RECORDS OF DIPTERA ASSOCIATED WITH FUNGI FROM THE CZECH AND SLOVAK REPUBLICS

ABSTRACT

New data on the biology of 60 species from 21 families of Diptera associated with fungi are
presented in this paper. Two species of Cecidomyiidae, Camptodiplosis auriculariae Buxton et Barnes,
1953 and Stomatosema nemorum Kieffer, 1904, are for the first time recorded from the Czech Republic. The first rearing record from fungi is provided for the species Tricimba albiseta Dely-Draskovits,
1983 (Chloropidae), Fannia umbrosa (Stein, 1895) (Fanniidae) and Mydaea nubila Stein, 1916 (Muscidae).
